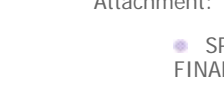

European Region (EUR)

New European Aviation Overview: Latest trends for the period 26 June-2 July



Our latest European Aviation Overview gives you all the facts and figures you need to understand how the European aviation network is developing as we head into peak summer traffic.

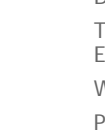
The week 26 June-2 July saw traffic return to normal following the successful conclusion of Air Defender in the previous week with arrival and departure punctuality continuing to improve and closing the gap on 2019 levels, and week-on-week traffic growth increasing, with a new post-COVID high set on Friday 30 June.

Key data in this network:

- The network recorded 32 998 average daily flights (+8% vs 2022), increasing (+2%) vs the previous week and standing at 93% of 2019 levels.
- On Friday 30 June 2023, the network recorded its highest number of flights (34 042) since the beginning of COVID - although still 8.5% below the record for the busiest day ever (28 June 2019).
- The Top 10 aircraft operators recorded flight growth of +2.1% vs the previous week.
- June, the number of flights in the European aviation network was 92% of 2019 levels, just below our Base scenario of forecasted flights released in December 2022.
- Arrival and departure punctuality closed at 3 percentage points each below 2019 levels.
- The jet fuel price closed at 2.32 USD/gallon on 30 June 2023, increasing (+4%) over 2 weeks. Current prices have however decreased by 25% compared to the beginning of the year.

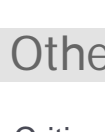

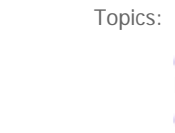

Please note that the next CAT CAG is scheduled for November 14/15 and I hope that many of you will be able to join the meeting here in Cologne (there will be webex session available as well).

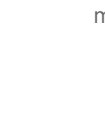

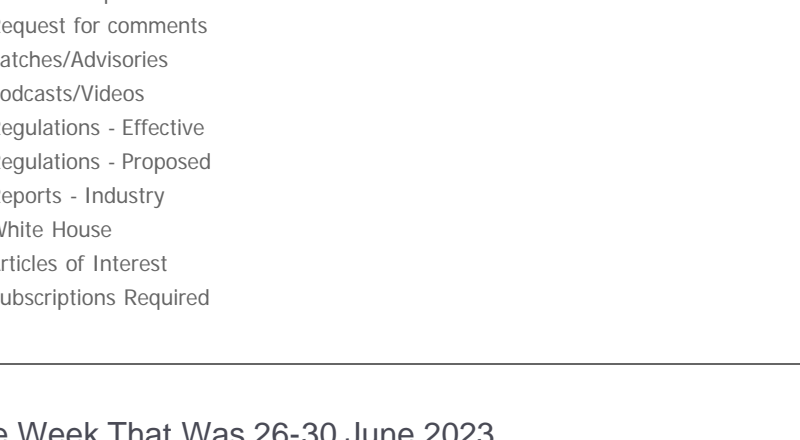

Critical importance of using correct QNH for RNP VNAV/LNAV approaches using baro-VNAV minima

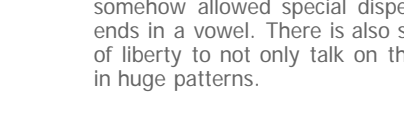


On 23 May 2022, an aircraft came extremely close to collision with terrain as the crew commenced a go around after they did not obtain any visual reference during a RNP approach at Paris CDG for which they were using baro-VNAV reference to fly to VNAV/LNAV minima. The corresponding LS was out of service. The investigation has not yet completedly established the context to test & evaluate regulations, and what lessons were learned from USSP's supporting large scale multi-vendor drone operations, in complex environments.

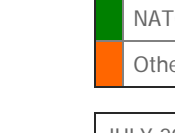

In this month's report, I read how May 2023 was the busiest month in the skies since July 2019, with an average of 133,800 flights and 240,900 flight hours operated daily. With July normally being the busiest month of any year for air traffic volumes, this bodes well for traffic recovery in 2023.
